Results in 2023

- › Reported quantities per category
 - ❖ General: 2,8 tonnes (12% based on this category in 2021)
 - ❖ Oil: 59,6 tonnes (35% based on this category in 2021)
 - ❖ LNG: 26,4 tonnes (0.4% based on this category in 2021)
 - ❖ LPG: 42.1 tonnes (1.2% based on this category in 2021)



Reporting in 2024

- › The working method was adjusted based on feedback and internal evaluations:
 - ❖ The reporting form has been adjusted, there now is a reporting form for the agent, and a reporting form for the principal
 - ❖ A document has been drawn up, containing frequently asked questions about the HNS Convention and the reporting
 - ❖ All documents and information are now available in English as well
 - ❖ Two information sessions in Dutch and English
 - ❖ A web page about the HNS Convention is online on the Dutch government website, containing relevant information and all documents for reporting



Results in 2024

- › Reported quantities per category
 - ❖ General: 17,3 million tonnes (81% based on this category in 2021)
 - ❖ Persistent oil: 79,3 million tonnes (110% based on this category in 2021)
 - ❖ Non-persistent oil: 6,9 million tonnes (14,5% based on this category in 2021)
 - ❖ LNG: 11,4 million tonnes (180% based on this category in 2021)
 - ❖ LPG: 1,7 million tonnes (50% based on this category in 2021)
